01. If a professional is prosecuted without any basis, then the profession will be in peril.

04. Whether a panel valuer is at fault when the deed is found as forged at a later date.

05. Liability against a professional arises only when he is an active participant in a plan to defraud the bank.

06. A valuer is not competent to certify the genuineness of the title.

07. Valuer is not responsible to detect the forged document.

08. Blacklisting a valuer cannot be done just like that without following the procedure and principle of natural justice.

09. The valuer cannot quote any internal correspondence (it may be confidential also) of the bank for representing his grievances against the bank.

10. Mere negligence would not make a professional for a criminal offence in the absence of any tangible evidence.

11. A valuer has no role to verify the title of the documents.

12. In the matters of "contract", unless the orders are wholly arbitrary or unreasonable, the court will decline to exercise its jurisdiction.
